Thanks to the generosity of LA Urban Farms, we are using the Mission's rooftop to transform this unused space into an urban oasis. Still in its early stages, this project has the potential to grow healthy food for students at the Mission and for others in need.

These amazing "vertical gardens" need no soil and allow us to use 90% less water =ARMS than traditional growing methods. This innovative and sustainable technology also lets us grow 10 times more fruits, vegetables, herbs, and edible flowers by growing vertically than if we were growing horizontally in the same space.

Wendy Coleman, founder of LA Urban Farms, says "The Los Angeles Mission is such an essential organization in our city, and this is a great opportunity to help provide healthy, local food in abundance for those who need it most."
