

## "More than my life, this place saved my soul!"

After the deaths of the grandparents who helped raise him and, just a year later, losing his mom, Nilban says, "I lost myself." He turned to alcohol to fill the void in his heart and ended up in the hospital, ready to give up on life. When he was released, the hospital chaplain suggested he come to Los Angeles Mission.

"When I found Los Angeles Mission and could count on a meal, a clean shirt and a place to stay, I started smiling. I knew I wanted to live and there would be a brighter tomorrow." Counseling helped Nilban come to terms with the painful losses of the people closest to him and he set a new course.

This holiday season, he is grateful to be reuniting with extended family and celebrating his new job as a laborer apprentice learning how to build tunnels and bridges.
