Dear Caring Friend,



# A 200% increase in requests for food means more opportunity for change

Recently, we've seen a 200% increase in requests for food, further evidence that **the hunger crisis in Los Angeles is worsening**.

More hardworking parents have lost their jobs and are now draining their life savings. Families who've never needed help before are being forced from their homes and onto the streets.

That's where Hugo found himself before walking through our doors. "I was sad, really just broken . . . I felt alone," he remembers.

But sadness turned into hope when Hugo came to Los Angeles Mission, allowing him to finally close out a horrible chapter in his life that included depression, joblessness and homelessness.

Here, the meals and shelter he was offered helped clear his head. He found purpose and hope in our recovery program. And now he gets great joy from sharing his story with other men, some of whom have come into this program themselves.

Hugo is excited about the future due to the encouragement and support he received from his new family at Los Angeles Mission. He's also grateful for the generosity of friends like you, who made it possible for him to move beyond the pain from his past.

### 'I wouldn't be alive today if it wasn't for this place'

Skid Row is full of predators who prey on defenseless, homeless women like Serina day and night.

When she wasn't being physically and verbally abused by her boyfriend, Serina constantly found herself pushed and shoved by his heartless friends, who took advantage of the fact that she was partially blind from being beaten so badly.

"It really kills your spirit," she says of the abuse she endured. "I didn't have anyone to protect me" . . . until she came to the Anne Douglas Center at Los Angeles Mission.

The feeling of finally being in a safe place, where she could do something as simple as brush her hair without being harassed, was "pretty overwhelming," she remembers. "I wouldn't be alive today if it wasn't for this place. I really felt like God led me here."

After 10 months of nutritious meals, Bible study, prayer support, and guidance, Serina says she's starting to feel normal again.

"I have goals and dreams now," she says. "I've gotten back my dignity and self-worth."

Hundreds of women at the Anne Douglas Center have come out of homelessness and have hope again because of your generosity. Thank you for continuing to support the life-changing programs that give hope and real help to women every day!

More families are becoming homeless for the first time than at any time in Los Angeles history. Sadly, many have no choice but to separate — dads going one place, moms and kids ending up somewhere else.

But at Los Angeles Mission, one of our top priorities is to get family members back together as quickly as possible. We do this through innovative programs like:

- The Anne Douglas Center, offering counseling, career skills development and transitional housing to women looking to transform their lives and regain their dignity after a tragedy.
- LifeStart, helping men and women overcome the obstacles they face so they can successfully meet the challenges of being in a work environment.
- Signature programs that provide mental health treatment, medical and dental services, and financial management classes to help prevent homelessness the next time a crisis hits.
