## This Easter, Mella Is a New Creation — Thanks to You!

"When I used to look in a mirror, all I could see was a lost little girl," says Mella, who currently resides at the Anne Douglas Center for Women at Los Angeles Mission.

Mella grew up in a loving, church-going home. She was a straight-A student at school. Her future looked bright.

But that all changed when she was kidnapped, raped and trafficked at the age of 15.

Although Mella was rescued a few months later, she could never escape the memories and trauma. For nearly 30 years, she's suffered from PTSD and panic attacks, and even more abuse from the men she's dated. When Mella finally fought back, she ended up in jail for assault. The judge then ordered her to the Anne Douglas Center for Women.

"I've been in therapy here, and I have an incredible case manager," Mella says. "They remind me that, in Jesus, I'm a new creation. God is miraculously transforming me, and I'm now beginning to help other women here who have experienced so much pain, like me."

"When I look into a mirror today, I see love. I see Mella, child of God," she says. "I want to thank the donors, because they gave me this chance to live and love again."

### Resurrected from His Fears, Thanks to God and You!

Thirty years ago, 24-year-old Cesareo rushed to the hospital, seriously ill. He was sure he was going to die. Even his doctors thought so. But he didn't die ...

Cesareo had struggled with fear and crippling insecurity his entire life. Although he didn't die in the hospital, his illness continued to sap his strength, and his fears and self-esteem plummeted. In a place of tragic weakness, he turned to meth to get him through each day.

Finally, last year, Cesareo snapped and ended up in jail. The judge ordered him to come to Los Angeles Mission.

"I was really afraid at first," Cesareo says. "But everyone at the Mission welcomed me and loved me. No one had ever talked to me about God before, but I started to see how God worked so many miracles here. Since I came here, I've dedicated my life to God. I don't care what anyone thinks about me anymore. I only care what God thinks."

Cesareo has been drug-free for more than a year now, and he's deeply grateful for people like you who helped save his life. "Thank you," he says. "Please keep donating, because there's no place else like this. The help I got here has been incredible."

Congratulations! If you have a completed, legal Will, you already understand the peace of mind that comes from having a plan in place. But before you check "Will planning" off your to-do list, make sure you aren't settling for one of these not-so-helpful documents.

#### 1. The Will That Missed the Mark

Through your Will, you not only care for the needs of your loved ones, but you can also give to ministries like Los Angeles Mission in a significant way. Does your Will reflect your values? Make sure your Will mirrors what matters most to you.

#### 2. The Will That's Out of Date

If your goals and circumstances have evolved, or if it's been more than three years since you last looked at your Will, it's probably time to dust it off and review it thoroughly.

If there's one thing that can render your Will useless, it's if no one knows where to find it. Make sure you tell your family practical details like where documents are stored and any lock combinations or keys they'll need to access them.
